- Pledge "Loving the Lord Jesus, I promise to take an active part in the work of the Adventist Youth Society, doing what I can to help others and to finish the work of the gospel in all the world."



ORGANIZATION MODULE – PURPOSE, NEED AND VALUE

Membership – 3 Types/Categories

- Regular Members: Members of the SDA Church in good and regular standing
- Associate Members: Not members of the Seventh-day Adventist Church, but
 - have Christian ideals and desire to be associated with the

young people of the church in missionary work

- May not hold office
- Encourage to become regular members as soon as possible
- .Honorary Members: Adult members of the church who support the YaYA



#2: LEADERSHIP MODULE



LEADERSHIP MODULE – PURPOSE, NEED AND VALUE

- The **Leadership module** incorporates aspects of training and actual practice of those activities required for senior leadership, and includes both philosophical base and practical practices.
- Ideal Leadership In the Steps of the Master
- Psychology of the Christian Leader
- Leadership Theories, Styles and Functions
- Meeting Management When You are the Chairperson of a Committee or Business Meeting
- How God Prepares His leaders



LEADERSHIP MODULE – CHRIST THE MODEL LEADER

Christ the Model Leader

"And he saith unto them, Follow me, and I will make you fishers of men" (Matt 4:19).

• Jesus Led by His Life

"What he taught, he was. his words were the expression, not only of his own life experience, but of his own character. not only did he teach the truth, but he was the truth. it was this that gave his teaching, power" (*Education*, pp. 78, 79). Jesus was Sympathetic and Understanding of the Needs of Others

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LEADERSHIP MODULE – Christ the model leader

Christ the Model Leader

"And he saith unto them, Follow me, and I will make you fishers of men" (Matt 4:19).

- Jesus was Kind and Thoughtful
- Jesus saw every person as a Candidate for Heaven
 - "For God so loved the world that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life" (John 3:16)
- Jesus Had a Sense of Mission
- "Why were you searching for me?' he asked, 'Didn't you know I had to be in my Father's house?" (Luke 2:49)



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#3: COMMITMENT MODULE



COMMITMENT MODULE – PURPOSE, NEED AND VALUE

• The Commitment Module:

- Is dedicated to strengthening the spiritual life of youth and youth leaders (Youth Upreach)
- Primarily revolves around those activities and programs that:
 - Are Devotional in Nature
 - Weeks of Prayer or Weeks of Spiritual Emphasis
 - Morning Watch/Devotional Personal and/or Family
 - Bible Conferences
 - Provide for special affirmation and celebration opportunities.
 - **Commitment Celebration** is a time of reaffirmation of a youth's continuing faith and confidence in God
 - The celebration of baptism (recent or past)



#4: DISCIPLESHIP MODULE



DISCIPLESHIP MODULE – PURPOSE, NEED AND VALUE

- **Discipleship Module** deals with how to:
- Help youth become disciples of the Lord
- Stay committed to that way of life (school, work and home and family life situations)

• Ultimately, YaYAs become disciples of the Lord and are equipped to share in this experience.

#5: WITNESSING MODULE



WINNING SOULS FOR CHRIST

• "When the youth give their hearts to God, our responsibility for them does not cease. They must be interested in the Lord's work, and led to see that he expects them to do something to advance his cause. It is not enough to show how much needs to be done, and to urge **the youth** to act a part. They must be taught how to labor for the Master. They **must be trained**, **disciplined**, drilled, in the best methods of winning souls to Christ. Teach them to try in a quiet, unpretending way to help their young companions. Let different branches of missionary effort be systematically laid out, in which they may take part, and let them be given instruction and help. Thus they will learn to work for God" (Gospel Workers, p. 27 210).

- The purpose of the **Worship module** is to give youth leaders ideas to help Adventist young people discover the joy of worship, and how to adopt a worshipful spirit while attending church

WORSHIP MODULE – PURPOSE, NEED AND VALUE

• What is Worship?

- Worship is not merely attending church.
- The religious exercise of worship includes:
 - Learning to live in God's presence
 - Integrating those things learned at church into one's daily living
- Growing in nurture
- Celebrating in Worship



CREATE WORSHIP EXPERIENCE FOR ALL

- Young people need to feel involved in your church's worship
- Create a worship experience that meets at least some needs of people of all generations all the time
- Re-prioritize our joint worship generational needs
 Children and Youth should be our first priority



CREATE WORSHIP EXPERIENCE FOR ALL

Ways we may transform our church worship service to meet the needs of our children, youth and young adults

Creativity: Try something new - change the routine
Practicality: They need a service that gives them something they can apply to their everyday lives
Relevancy: Choose illustrations that come from the world they are familiar with, not only from the adult/Ghanaian world

 Contemporary: Use current language and illustrations and <u>include</u> music children and young people understand
 Variety: They like different approaches, different styles, even ³⁴ different locations for worship

FELLOWSHIP – PURPOSE, NEED AND VALUE

 Purpose - The Fellowship module is designed to guide youth leaders in finding resources to help provide *meaningful recreation* for the AY Society

• Need

- Guidance of YaYA to discover and take part in meaningful recreation
- Learning how to deal with leisure time
- Defining recreation and entertainment
- Adoption of proper practices that reflect the Adventist ³⁶ lifestyle adopted.

EMPOWERING YAYA – PURPOSE, NEED AND VALUE

- Purpose The **Empowering YaYA module** is a summary of the whole purpose of YaYA Ministries in the SDA Church
- YaYA Ministries are Salvation and Service focused through:
 - Discipleship
 - Leadership
 - Evangelism
 - Service/Missions



EMPOWERING YAYA – PURPOSE, NEED AND VALUE

- Need The **Empowering YaYA module** is needed to empower:
 - YaYA to be strong Christians
 - YaYA to participate in the mission of the church.
 - All church members to appreciate that ours is a Salvation and Service for all Ages



EMPOWERING YAYA – PURPOSE, NEED AND VALUE

Value

- Salvation and Service Outcomes
- It combines the above 7 modules into 4 strategic themes:
 - Discipleship Strategies
 - Leadership Strategies
 - Mission/Service Strategies
 - Evangelism Strategies

WHAT IS YOUTH AND YOUNG ADULT DEVELOPMENT?

Includes

- Providing them unique opportunities and support for self-development of healthy personal relationship with the Lord
- Nurturing their spiritual lives so they become worthy ambassadors of Christ
- Equipping them to minister effectively in the church and society
- Building and strengthening their individual and group mental, social and physical capacities
 - Career counseling
 - Mentoring
 - Leadership training



WHAT OTHER STAKEHOLDERS NEED TO DO



DEVELOP AND NURTURE YOUTH AND YOUNG ADULTS

- Remember the story of John Mark, Barnabas' young cousin, who accompanied Paul and Barnabas on a missionary journey, but turned back out of discouragement
- <u>Trusting youth to take leadership and ownership is risky</u>, because they will make mistakes. But like Jesus with His disciples, <u>let us be patient with their mistakes</u>.
- <u>Paul is not the example</u> we should strive to follow. Rather, <u>church leaders should endeavor to follow Barnabas' example</u>.
- Have <u>faith in young people</u>, <u>be patient</u> with them, **trust** them, and watch them grow!



A NEW MINDSET FOR YOUNG PEOPLE

Youth and young adults should have:

- A teachable and humble spirit
- A mindset to grow/change/develop
- A mindset to meet challenge, yet not to be stopped by them

• Young people should change poor attitude towards selfdevelopment and personal empowerment

 Leadership is earned by those who have been prepared for it by God through various means



Resolve Conflicts The Right Way

- Take Redemptive, Nurturing Approach in Resolving Conflicts Among Youth, Young Adults, Adults and Church Leaders
 - Young people Church Leaders Conflicts



ORGANIZE REGULAR BAPTISMAL CLASSES AND ENCOURAGE BAPTISMS

• <u>Work with your youth leaders</u> to approach young people about baptism and plan either one-on-one studies or group baptismal classes for those interested in joining the church through baptism

Focus on:

- Providing a clear understanding of the Church's fundamental beliefs
- A saving relationship with Jesus
- Encouraging some would-be baptismal candidates to wait until they are a little older 51
- Avoiding rushed baptisms following an emotionally charged event



TRANSMIT OUR LIFESTYLE STANDARDS TO YOUNG PEOPLE

• Be The Sermon

- Young people despise inconsistency and hypocrisy in elders/leaders /adults
- It is not unusual to observe a degree of rebellion among adolescence
- Young people want to know Why?
 - We need to be prepared to talk about our values when we ⁵² discuss lifestyle issues with youth
