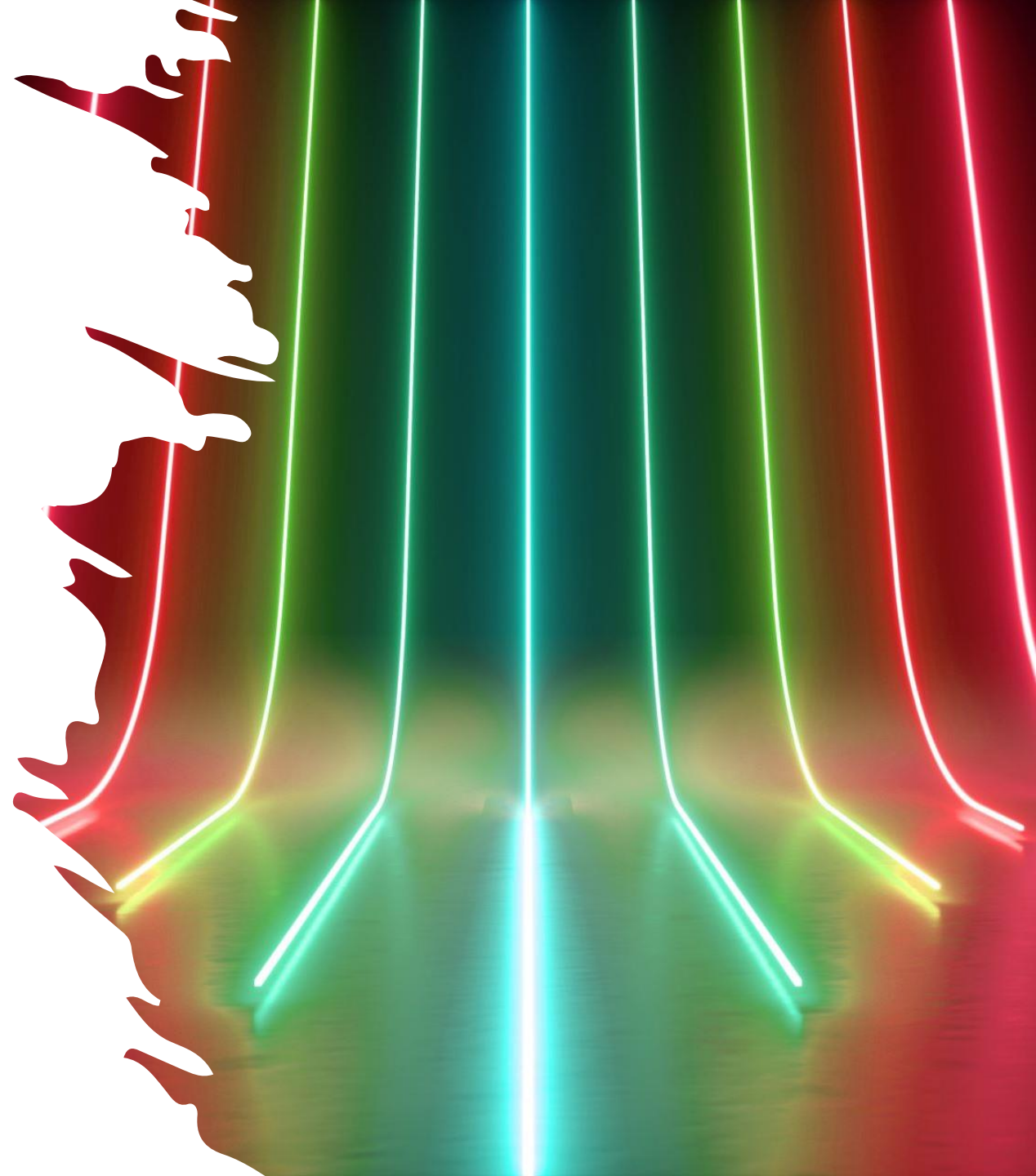

WHAT IS WORSHIP?

- In Christianity, **worship** is the act of attributing reverent honor and homage to God.

TWO TYPES OF WORSHIP

- 1. True worship
- 2. False worship

WORSHIP HAS ALWAYS BEEN AN ISSUE OF CONTENTION

- Satan's rebellion in Heaven was centered on worship
- Cain & Abel was about worship.
- The contest between Elijah and the priests of Baal had to do with worship
- Daniel and his three Hebrew friends were tested on the issue of worship
- One of the temptations of Christ in the wilderness dealt with worship.

WHAT IS MINISTRY AND CHURCH MEETINGS?

- Ministry: In the Greek language, the term always centers on the acts of service to others.
- **Ministry is what we do for God's glory based on where He has placed us, how He has gifted us, and what He has called us to do according to His infinite wisdom and for the proclamation of the gospel.**
- Eg. Music, Evangelism, caring, etc.

CHURCH MEETINGS

- **A church meeting is a group of believers gathered to seek, to do the will of Christ for his church.**
- **Eg. Youth & Young Adult Camp, CYP, Church board meeting, Etc.**

SURVEY ON WHAT YOUNG PEOPLE DON'T LIKE ABOUT OUR WORSHIP/CHURCH MEETINGS

- 22% also said **the church ignores real-world problems**
- 18% said that their church was too concerned about the negative impact of movies, music and video games.
- One-third of survey participants felt that “church is boring”.
- The church service is dominated by the old people.
- Some also feel that churches are too simple or too judgmental when it comes to issues of sexuality.

COMPLAINS FROM SOME NAGSDA YAYA

- 1. Sermons are not relatable.
- 2. Language (value salvation rather than Nationality/tribe)
- 3. Hijack of the leadership by the adults.
- 4. Judgmental
- 5. The church is not ready for change.

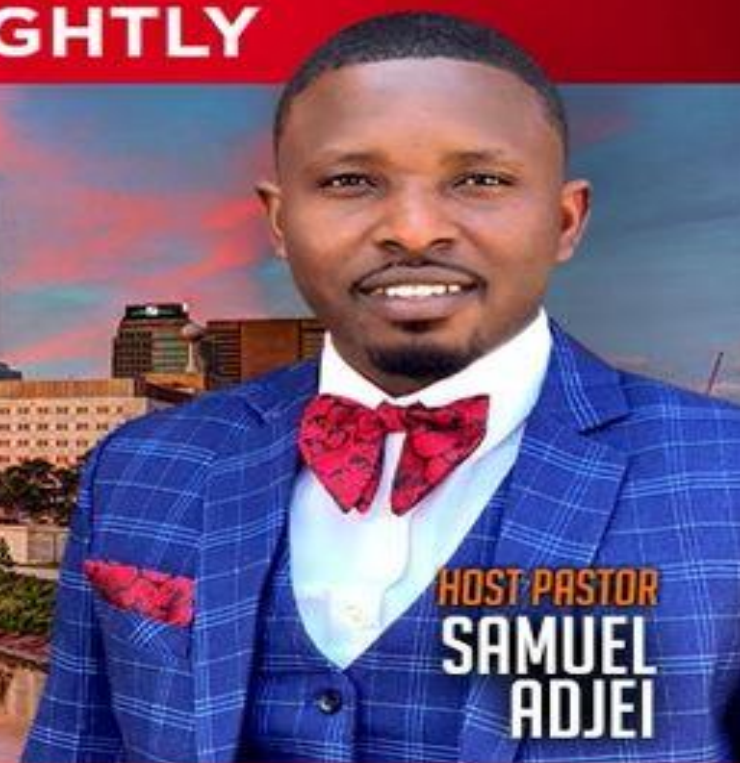

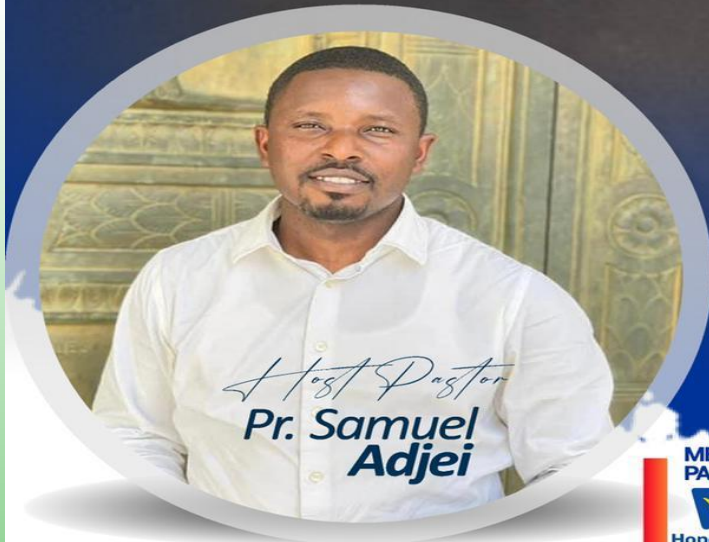

English Service at Columbus Ghanaian Sees Growth

The English service at the Columbus Ghanaian Adventist Church (CGAC) recently held its 2022 Summer Revival Summit, finishing a fruitful evangelistic season. CGAC pastors Samson Twumasi (pictured, top) and Samuel Adjei (bottom) hosted the revival, featuring messages from Nic Coutet, lead pastor of the Adventist Fellowship church in Tulsa, Okla. At the end of the meetings, nine people gave their lives to Christ through baptism.

The CGAC English service began in March of 2021, with a mission to reach second- and third-generation Ghanaians born in the United States.



“Our vision is twofold here: to rescue the youth and young adults we are losing in the Adventist Church and empower them for mission work,” says Adjei.

Since its inception last year, the CGAC English service has become a multi-nationality community church, reaching more

than just Ghanaians. The service began with some 30 members and has now grown to a membership of 80 young adults.

In 2021, the CGAC English service celebrated 30 baptisms. With the nine baptisms following this summer’s evangelistic campaign, the year-to-date total has increased to 19.

Adjei adds, “As we have begun to hold services in English, young adults feel comfortable inviting people from their social networks to join them at church. We have become a welcoming home for neighbors and friends here in Columbus.”
