# REVIVAL DEVOTIONAL

## COME ALIVE

Hello NAGSDA YaYA family! We truly are in a season of revival and no one is getting left behind. As we draw closer to Jesus during this time, we want to invite you into intentional time with the Lord through fasting and prayers. We are anchoring the focus of the fast and prayers in our theme: **Come Alive: Elijah's Message**. We all know that in order for someone or something to come alive, there needs to be a recognition of life experiences such as dryness, nothingness, or darkness in that thing or person.

This can be a spiritual, emotional, relational, or even financial kind of death. But Jesus is in the business of reviving and restoring our whole selves. He desires for us to live life and live it **more abundantly**. We do not want any walking "dead" kind of lifestyle. So let us invite Jesus into those places of our lives that are holding us back and not bearing any good fruit. Let us receive the fullness of life Jesus died for.

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**Scripture:** Ezekiel 37:1-9, John 10:10

### **Reflective Prayer:**

Our fasting and prayers is to intentionally usher you into uninterrupted quality time with the Lord. We believe the Lord wants you to come away from all the distractions, and the hustle into the peaceful, and sweet anointing of His presence. God desires you to come fully alive in Him, so let us make it happen. You can be safe, vulnerable, and honest with Him. He can help you Come Alive.

The questions on the next page are to guide you to press in as you journal with the Lord and invite Him to breathe into every dry place in your life.

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### Reflective Prayer continues:

- What area(s) of your life seems dry, meaningless, or dark?
- What are the things causing this dryness, meaninglessness, or darkness?
- When did you start to recognize these types of dryness, meaninglessness, and darkness in your life?
- Are these life experiences patterns in your family, personal life, culture, or church community?
- What family member, friend or loved one is also experiencing death, dryness, and emptiness in their lives?

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### Reflective Prayer continues:

- Begin to pray and talk to the Lord about these things. Pay attention to yourself and recognize any emotion that may arise at this time.
- Be silent, listen, and pay attention to what the Spirit of God may be showing you, speaking to you, or impressing on your heart. What songs, images, or Scriptures are coming up for you? Write down what you are sensing from the Holy Spirit.
- Now begin to pray again and declare what the Lord spoke or revealed to you. In Genesis 1:1-3, we know that in the place of darkness, void, and emptiness, the words God spoke (Let there be light - Genesis 1:3) reversed all the darkness and brought life, light, and beauty into what we know as earth. The only thing that can revive the dry places in your life is **God's WORD and SPIRIT.**

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### Reflective Prayer continues:

- How can you live out this new, revived, fruitful, and vibrant life?
- Now, take some time to listen to the Lord and ask Him; whom does He want you to intercede for? Allow the Holy Spirit to lead you as you pray for the person or people God brought to your mind and pressed on your heart.
- Finish your time with worship, praise, and even dance. Give God all the glory for the work He has begun in your life. Your revival is not just an event, but will become a lifestyle in Jesus' name! Can WE hear Amen?
